





COVID-19 death rates are highest among **Whites**.


Among Heart Disease deaths


Behavioral Risk Factors⁶

Behavioral risk factors estimate the prevalence of personal health behaviors that can affect morbidity and mortality. Engaging in negative behaviors can increase the likelihood of developing or worsening chronic diseases.

Adults who binge drink	18%
Adults with Diabetes	11.7%
Adults who currently use e-cigarettes	7.5%
Adults who smoke	24%
Adults who are obese	41%
Adults who are obese or overweight	64.6%


