






TOP 5 LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH


Behavioral Risk Factors⁶

Behavioral risk factors estimate the prevalence of personal health behaviors that can affect morbidity and mortality. Engaging in negative behaviors can increase the likelihood of developing or worsening chronic diseases.



2021-2022 High School Graduates by Race/Ethnicity






Food Environment Index²-
